help is a call away

A fter years of attending the same idyllic summer camp by the pond in Vermont, this year my friend's college-age daughter got the job she'd been dreaming of since she was nine. Head camp counselor.

At the end of June, everything was going swimmingly. The first session of kids went home delighted and exhausted, and the new campers were adjusting well. There were a few bed-wetters and some homesickness, but nothing to write home about.

And then it got hot. Really hot. And then it started to rain. And it rained hard.

Inside, watching yet another G-rated movie with the now irritable campers, the alert on her phone made the head counselor jump up and turn off the projector. Thunderstorms, high winds, and grapefruit-sized hail was on the way.

Most of the 100-year old camp was made up of tents on platforms. The only basement was under the cafeteria. That's where the head counselor demanded all of the 300 campers shelter themselves.

Outside, the pond became

a lake. Ancient trees were swept away like kites. The tents disappeared as if they were tissues. Most of the campers' belongings were lost. The hail dented cars and shattered windows.

But everyone was safe. Until the floor of the basement became damp. And then wet. And then the water was up to their ankles.

In the end, they all found shelter in the maintenance garage, which was more exposed, but on higher ground. No one drowned, or was even hurt. But most of the soggy campers did contract COVID and needed to be quarantined.

As we are all quickly learning, the above scenario can happen to any of us, anywhere, at any time.

Once the shock subsides after such a calamity, we all want relief to come just as quickly and effortlessly as the trauma did. MHEC contracts are designed to provide exactly that kind of relief for our member organizations across New England.
