As anyone serving the public knows, we're often required to find ways to do more with less, and the bigger the project, the more complex the funding challenges. Hewlett Packard Financial Services, which also provides these kinds of asset management solutions for IT, reports that 95% of all laptops and workstations they cover are upcycled and returned to active use, and 93% of the servers see new life beyond their initial installation.

Based in Syracuse, New York, **Ontario Investments** is registered as a small business, and they specialize in working with the kinds of tight budgets and complex terms and conditions state and local governments are required to meet.

Digital technology, though, is only one kind of the major equipment investments the suppliers on this contract manage.

UV Disinfectant Lighting new to G17

MEC has added "UV disinfecting lighting" as a new category to our contract for **Cus**todial Cleaning Equipment and Supplies (G17).

UVC lighting kills germs, bacteria, pathogens, and viruses in hospitals, laboratories, classrooms, and public spaces. Safe, effective, and odor-free, UVC lighting has been used as a means of disinfecting and sanitizing for decades. New technological advancements in response to COVID and the threat of other pandemics have expanded the options and improved the efficacy.

In awarding contracts to the following suppliers—Allston Supply, C&C Janitorial Supplies, Clean Green Solutions, Filter Sales & Service, Inc., Imperial Dade, and Likarr Maintenance Systems—MHEC now has a variety of products available to our members.

There are essentially three applications for UVC lighting systems—two kinds of built-in sys-



tems, and many portable options.

A number of companies, like **American Ultravi**olet, design fixtures to be installed discretely inside HVAC systems. Invisible to the public, they can be installed individually or in racks in a variety of locations such as coils, drain pans, exhausts, and duct work. Resistant to moisture, they can extend the lifetime of electrical connections as they filter the air for pathogens.

For medical facilities, or laboratories, where you need to track the efficacy of your UCV lighting system, **RD UVC** offers a fixed mounted system and a

mobile option (*pictured above*). Each floods a space with direct lighting and offers a system of sensors that measures the actual dose delivered. Medical facilities using the **RD-FxTM Fixed**

Mount System report it taking as little as two minutes to completely disinfect a room between patients.

PURO UV Disinfection Lighting also offers a range of options and products for sanitizing surfaces and small spaces discretely. Along with an HVAC system, they offer more compact devices, such as their **Aurora** air fan, which looks



like a space heater on wheels, or their **Whisper** device, a small box that attaches to surfaces, like an elevator ceiling, and continuously filters the air.

Offering two different takes on mobile UVC disinfection, there's **Pyure** and **Moonbeam™ 3. Pyure** offers a series of indus-

trial purifiers (the Boss is pictured above)meant to provide quiet, robust air purification and odor removal. Small and portable, once plugged in,

they silently scour the air. The **Moonbeam™3 UVC portable lamp system** (*pictured right*) by Diversey uses three individually-adjustable, articulating arms UVC lamp fixtures to provide targeted disinfection.
