cybersecurity

This October is the 20th anniversary of **Cybersecurity Awareness Month**, a collaboration between the National Cybersecurity Alliance and private business "to raise awareness about cybersecurity and empower everyone to protect their personal data from digital forms of crime."

We've all heard the stories: there's a lot of ways to be tricked on-line. Someone in a rush responds to a questionable email and suddenly computers crash. Surfing the web, a coworker clicks on a link and downloads malware that affects the whole office.

Extricating yourself from the very real trouble so easily caused can be much harder. Data-breeches, corporate espionage, and blackmail, all made easier by the same tools that you, your family, and workplace depend on.

Fortunately, there are steps people and organizations can take to protect themselves against cybercrime. The national website offers a range of advice and reporting for basic steps everyone can take.

These include using strong passwords and a password manager; turning on multifactor authentication when available; recognize and report phishing; and keep your sofware up-to-date (learn more at: staysafeonline.org/ programs/cybersecurity-awareness-month/).

Beyond basic digital hygene, MHEC contracts have New England educational organizations and municipalities covered. Our **Network Infrastructure contract** (F14) has a wide selection of suppliers who can help you set up new networks, or improve existing ones. To help you protect your digital investments, our contract for Insurance (IO2) includes options for cyber insurance. Both contracts are featured at the end of this issue.

W ith October being the 20th anniversary of Cybersecurity Awareness Month, MHEC wanted to share the resources available through our portfolio of contracts that can help our members keep their networks strong, resilient, and insured against intrusion and data loss.

Every year digital technologies become more powerful, but also systems become more complex. In addition to words and numbers, to support our meetings, our networks now need to deliver multiple, syrnchronized audio and video feeds on demand. To keep pace with the swiftly evolving cutting edge, the suppliers on our contracts offer a wide range of products and services that help make these advances comprehensible and working for your organization—not against it.

CYBERSECURITY ASSET MANAGEMENT

What devices connect to your systems? This is an important question in creating a comprehensive cyber security plan. Aramis is a solution offered by **NEWCOM Wireless** Services on our **Technology contract (F05)**.

Aramis is a device security platform, designed to protect organizations from cyberthreats created by the onslaught of unmanaged devices. It's available to our members through **NEWCOM Wireless Services on** our **Technology Contract (F05)**.

Once, it was a lot easier knowing your network and the devices on it were secure. If needed, it was possible to sever all connection with the outside world and keep an ever-vigilant eye on what data came into your system and what left it. Those days are largely behind us now.

Today, as the dependence on cloudbased and cellular solutions increases, it's becoming harder and harder to track all the components that conect to our networks. Now, instead of just a web of servers, computers, and laptops, we've got microwave ovens, refrigerators, and toys that connect to the internet. The highly technical term for all these web-aware products is the "Internet of Things," or IoT.

Aramis helps organizations identify and track all the different IoT devices that interact with their network. Along with discovering when and where digital assets are being used, Aramis can tell whether they are missing critical security agents or updates, which applications are being using and if there are vulnerabilities.

If a risk is identified, the software will assess the degree of the threat (based on user-defined criteria), and automatically address it, if necessary. This can include preventing the device from connecting, issuing a warning to the user, or kicking off a process to install an upgrade or patch.
