Finally, it's safe to take the airconditioners out of the window, fire up the furnace, and hunker down inside. Another New England winter is upon us all, and it's time to give serious thought to interior furnishings. MHEC has you covered on all fronts.

Maybe it's time to replace that buzzing microwave with the dial, or the refrigerator in the dorm kitchen needs an upgrade. Our contract for **Appliances**, **Air Conditioners**, **Food Service Equipment & Laundry Equipment**, **Supplies and Services (A01)** is likely to have exactly what you need to replace a couple items, or have maintenance done on a whole building full of outdated equipment.

As technology transforms our environments with wall-sized screens, interactive kiosks, and LED lighting options, our contract for **Multimedia Equipment & Services** (B11) can help help members master the many options out there.

The **Signage (G24)** contract helps our members make their organizations stand out. This might be as simple as a nameplate, or as complex as a building marquee or wraps for your fleet of vehicles.

If you have short-term needs for a big event—you need to rent a tent, or have someone help you throw a convention—the suppliers on our contract for **Event Equipment Rentals (B15)** can take on all sizes and kinds of engagements.

The Windows, Window Treatments and Curtains (C04) and the Mattresses & Hospitality (C05) contracts should be of anyone with windows or a bathroom (in other words: everyone!). Similarly, our Flooring (G11) contract provides many options for improving all kinds of spaces.

With the ability to fine-tune the pattern colors, and control over the shape and orientation of the tiles, the results are stunning and instintaneous. You can save presets to share with your staff and designer.
